Old Business: None



Steve Bruce made a motion to approve the Amendment to the 2025 Salary Ordinance, second by Auburn Patmore, motion carried.


Utility Report: Gary Higgs stated the looping project on Folsomville Degonia has been completed, other then going back through and putting down grass and straw.
